

## Steps for 100 Facts

1. Create (with others who teach the same material) a basic curriculum of information they simply need to know.
2. Put the 100 questions on 3 X 5 index cards and put them in a box (or hat).
3. Before introducing the curriculum to them, give the students a 10-point quiz on a Friday and chart the results for the entire class. Explain the concept of a *baseline*.
4. Give your students the curriculum and indicate that it is their responsibility to learn the material on their own (with help).
5. On the next Friday, give them a quiz (random) and chart the results.
6. Set some goals along the way and celebrate the attainment of each.
7. Post the charts so students can see their progress.
